GEOGRAPHY

Capital: Tarrodo

Tarrodan is divided into three distinct geographical and political regions.

• Flumevale

Known for its expansive forests, winding rivers, and fertile agricultural plains, Flumevale is often referred to as "The Heartland of Tarrodan." The Great Flume River serves as a vital artery for transportation and irrigation. Crops such as golden wheat and ambervinia berries thrive here.

• Lyndrassia

Dominated by rolling hills and the towering Lyndrian Peaks, capped with snow year-round, Lyndrassia is rich in mineral deposits and supports a strong mining industry. The serene meadows at the base of the mountains are dotted with quaint villages and vibrant alpine flora.

Navaldia

This coastal region is defined by its rugged cliffs, sandy beaches, and bustling harbors. The Ruby Wave Archipelago lies just offshore, known for its rich marine biodiversity and vibrant coral reefs. This region is a hub for shipbuilding, fishing, and trade, with its port cities often buzzing with activity.

HISTORY

Tarrodan's history is a tale of unity forged from diversity.

- Early Tribes and Unification: Over 1,200 years ago, the Tarrosian tribes, each with distinct cultures, came together under the leadership of Vehlan the Visionary to resist external threats. This unification laid the foundation for the nation.
- The Treaty of Lyndrassia (834 CE): After decades of internal conflict, this treaty established a framework for regional autonomy under a central government.
- The Maritime Renaissance (1450–1550 CE): Navaldia's fleets expanded Tarrodan's influence through exploration and trade, bringing wealth and fostering a golden age of art and science.
- Modernization (19th–20th centuries): The adoption of the Qalkoon currency and the development of national railways connected the regions and promoted economic integration. Recent decades have seen a focus on renewable energy and digital innovation.

Official Languages: Tarrosian (national); Flumish, Lyndral (regional dialects)

Tarrodan's culture is deeply rooted in the unique traditions of its three regions while embracing national unity.

- Cuisine
 - **Flumevale**: Known for hearty stews and fresh produce. Dishes often include root vegetables, grains, and slow-roasted meats.
 - **Lyndrassia**: Famous for its spiced breads, mountain honey, and dishes featuring the Meadow Glimmer Hare, served during the Winterlight Festival.
 - **Navaldia**: Renowned for its seafood, with dishes like spiced Glitterfinstew and grilled Ruby Wave Navalarafish.
- Art and Literature: The country's murals, often depicting scenes from the *Legends of Vehlan*, are celebrated for their intricate designs. Epic poetry is a cornerstone of Tarrosian literature, with oral storytelling still practiced in rural areas.
- Music and Dance: Traditional music, centered around the tarloon, is often accompanied by regional dances. Lyndrassian folk dances, characterized by intricate footwork, are performed at festivals and celebrations.

NATIONAL CELEBRATIONS

- Unity Day (March 15): Marked by parades, communal feasts, and performances, it commemorates the founding of Tarrodan.
- **Ruby Wave Festival (June)**: In Navaldia, sailing races, seafood feasts, and beach bonfires celebrate maritime heritage.
- Lyndrassian Winterlight Festival (December): Villages are illuminated with lanterns and torches, and traditional music fills the air.

FLORA AND FAUNA

Tarrodan's ecosystems are diverse and vibrant:

- Flumevale
 - o Flora: ancient flume trees, glowing lumina blossoms, and golden ambervinia.
 - o Fauna: river glide platypus, Flumevalian lynx, and migratory skyglider herons.
- Lyndrassia
 - o Flora: snow emberflowers and everbright pines with glowing resin.
 - o Fauna: majestic lyndrax, frostwing eagles, Lyndrassian penguins, and Meadow Glimmer Hares.
- Navaldia
 - o Flora: coastal mangroves, sea thistles, and ruby orchids found on the archipelago.
 - o Fauna: Navaldian dolphins, coral eels, and crimson wing gulls.

Sustainability efforts include protected areas like the Ruby Wave Marine Reserve and Great Flume Sanctuary.

NATURAL DISASTERS

Tarrodan faces several natural challenges:

- Flumevale: Periodic river flooding during spring thaws and heavy rains.
- Lyndrassia: Experiences avalanches during harsh winters and occasional earthquakes.
- Navaldia: Vulnerable to tropical storms and tsunamis due to its coastal location.

Disaster preparedness programs, early warning systems, and resilient infrastructure help mitigate these risks.

TRANSPORTATION

- **Roads and Highways**: The Unity Highway connects major cities, while rural areas rely on well-maintained regional roads.

- Traditional: Flumevale River Racing, Mountain Hurl in Lyndrassia, and wave sailing in Navaldia reflect the nation's heritage.
- Modern: League Ball, a fast-paced team sport, is the most popular national game.

- Outdoor activities like hiking, snorkeling, and eco-camping are widely enjoyed.
- Festivals like Unity Day and the Ruby Wave Festival showcase Tarrodan's cultural vibrancy.
